The board has dealt with several major issues with residents abusing back gate privileges. Please take notice that we have many cameras at the back gate, and we are in a continual video recording of ingress and egress. Over the past 2 weeks we have pulled passes from residents at 3 different homes, for all cars that are listed at the homes. At no time may a pass be used that is not attached to a car window. Piggy backing is not allowed. We have had several incidents with homeowners assisting their vendors to exit the gate. No trailers are allowed attached to your vehicle. Also, as a reminder we do have a pedestrian gate. You can obtain a key FOB for that gate by contacting our property management Vesta. Gate rules are posted on the website.

Our community takes pride in maintaining the beauty of Imperial. To continue the success of our community it is imperative that ARB rules be followed. BEFORE any work commences on the outside of your home, or when dumpster, porter potty or any type of trailer, is being used, an ARB must be submitted and approved. We currently have a major issue that we are working through that could have been avoided had the homeowner communicated with the board prior to beginning work.

One additional item is curbing your pets. Do not leave your pets waste bags in common areas. Take it with you!
